Principal's Report

- The school had a literacy aim for punctuation for all children in the school. The target was to increase the punctuation knowledge of 75% of the children. This goal was exceeded and 80% of the children showed an increased knowledge in punctuation after this focus. The next target will be for reading comprehension.
- All of the Wi-fi equipment has been delivered for the school. It will be up and running some time in Term 3.
- The school Disco will be run on Thursday the 27th June and has different times for the younger and older children. This is being put on by the Parent Club.
- Andy would like to have a working bee on Sunday the 20th July. The two items in most need:
 - o moving the mulch near the chicken coop to the adventure playground
 - o cleaning up the grounds around the OOSH Out of School Hours building
- The school is having a whole school activity night 5th September 2013 at Narrabeen Sports High School
- Andy is the relieving Principal till the end of Term 2, but Jim Delaney has not decided if he will be returning.

President's Report

- Risk Assessment requirements for P&C Jennifer has asked one of the parents if they would be willing
 to help with these the parent is thinking about it and will get back to her
- The risk assessments need to be completed before the Spring Fair on the 10th August to make sure that the insurances will cover the P&C

Spring Fair Update

- **URGENT!!!** A donations coordinator or 2 is needed for the spring fair. If you know of anyone who would be interested please let Jennifer know.
- Insurance cover for a wash out of the spring fair could be 30-40% more than the quote 2 years ago. Jennifer is still awaiting a quotation from the insurance provider.

An inflatable toys stall will be run again this year at the Spring Fair. Jennifer presented an update on SF11 schedule, made recommendations regarding SF13 expenditure. Expenditure was approved.

- Photographer services are being considered. P&C requested it be on a commission basis and that there be facility for purchasers to view the photos on the day.
- Possible Sea Eagles player to appear at Spring Fair Ian Phillips to ask players currently working with Reading Help. Sarah Jones to speak to former player Craig Hancock.
- Various options for counting SF proceeds and security generally were discussed. Andy Rankin to seek input from other schools.
- Final stall allocations will be completed by the next P&C meeting on the 16th July 2013.
